

# In Christ, I Am a New Creation 7-Day Devotional & Journal

Growing in Christ's Grace: Living Victoriously...Every day

## Day 1 - A Brand-New Beginning

**Scripture:** "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." - **2 Corinthians 5:17** 

**Reflection:** In Christ, your past no longer defines you. The old has been buried, and you have risen to new life. God doesn't just clean you up - He makes you new!

<b>Journal Prompt:</b> Write down one lie from your past that you've believed about yourself. Now write down the truth of God's Word that replaces it.
Day 2 – No Condemnation Scripture: "There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus." - Romans 8:1
<b>Reflection:</b> Guilt and shame are the enemy's tools, but Christ has declared you free. When the enemy reminds you of your past, remind him of the cross.
<b>Journal Prompt:</b> Reflect on times when you felt condemned. How does this verse assure you of your freedom in Christ?

## Day 3 - Pressing Forward

**Scripture:** "Forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal..." - Philippians 3:13–14

**Reflection:** Living victoriously requires letting go of yesterday's failures. God has prepared a future full of purpose for you. Victory comes by pressing forward in faith.

Journal Prompt: List 3 areas where you want to see victory in your life. Pray over them daily this week, declaring God's promises concerning your future - Jeremiah 29:11.
Day 4 – Brought Near by the Blood Scripture: "But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ." - Ephesians 2:13
<b>Reflection:</b> You are not distant from God—His blood has drawn you near. You are chosen, loved, and accepted.
<b>Journal Prompt:</b> Write a short prayer thanking God for bringing you close and making you His daughter.

Day 5 -	Rooted i	in Christ

Scripture: "Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, rooted and built up in him..." - Colossians 2:6-7 **Reflection:** Roots bring stability. The more rooted you are in Christ, the stronger and more fruitful you will become. Journal Prompt: Identify one spiritual habit (prayer, Bible study, worship, fellowship) you want to strengthen this week to stay rooted in Christ. Day 6 - Redeemed and Restored Scripture: "In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace." - Ephesians 1:7 Reflection: Redemption means you've been bought back. Christ paid the ultimate price to restore you. You are no longer bound by sin—you are free, forgiven, and whole. **Journal Prompt:** Identify at least 1 woman in your circle who may feel disqualified by her past. Commit to encouraging her with God's truth this week.

## **Day 7 – Living Victoriously Every Day**

**Scripture**: "But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." - 1 Corinthians 15:57

**Reflection:** Victory is not something you fight for—it's something you live from. In Christ, the battle is already won. You are victorious today, tomorrow, and forever in Him.
